# R<sub>4</sub>D

R4D – which stands for *Resilience for Dairy* – is the name chosen for an EU-funded project which aims to improve the European dairy sector's sustainability and resilience. In order to achieve this goal, the 18 partners of R4D have created a network enabling the exchange of practical and scientific knowledge among European dairy farmers, researchers and other relevant stakeholders.

### **Implementation**

In each participating country of the project, there will be one *Farm Facilitator (FF)*, one *Dairy Farm Network* as well as a *National Dairy AKIS (NDA)*. The FF will connect dairy farmers (Dairy Farm Network) and their associations, companies (animal feed, dairy, etc.), researchers and other stakeholders of the dairy sector to encourage the exchange of information and knowledge in the NDA.

In addition, Farm Facilitators will interact strongly with the Knowledge Facilitators of the three Knowledge Areas of dairy resilience to ensure that proposed solutions will be ready for practice and can be adopted by dairy farmers.

## PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION


#### Objectives
